- I would like to thank you once again for the fruitful meeting held on 20.06.2017 with your good self, to discuss the recommendations of Haryana State Commission for Protection of Child Rights for the welfare and rehabilitation of children of women prisoners in Haryana. In this regard, we would like you to request that necessary action may be taken on the following points;
1. The District Child Protection Units are to link cases of children of women prisoners with Child Welfare Committee of their respective districts for further enquiry and necessary directions in each case. It is requested to grant necessary permissions access and facilitate the process in such cases.
  2. In compliance with the judgments of Hon'ble Apex court, it is emphasized that, there should be separate barracks for women prisoners with children. Further, it is suggested that no police personnel should enter these barracks in their uniform
  3. The children in the age of 0-3 years to be linked with Anganwadi centres and 4-6 with main stream school as appropriate.
  4. The right for each child to have an identity is a fundamental human right which allows each individual the ability to enjoy all of their rights, therefore it is emphasized that Aadhar card and birth certificate should be provided to such children.
  5. It is very important that the children should not be deprived of the right to Play so crucial at their age. It is therefore requested that a specific play area may be designated/developed with adequate toys, play material for the children. This will definitely encourage critical and creative thinking in the children,

6. The children should be taken for weekly outdoor visit as far as possible. Prior plan may be developed and submitted to concerned authorities in this regard.
7. Children in jail shall be provided with adequate and suitable clothing
8. These children should also be linked with age appropriate health facilities, It is requested that suitable directions may be passed in this regard.

I thank you once again the interest shown and am confident that the discussion will manifest into actual change in the lives of these children. We would also appreciate if this Commission is informed about the action taken by your office in this regard.
